



Case Manager - Here For You Project

The Case Manager position is an exciting New position at Portage Path Behavioral Health as a result of a recently awarded grant. The "Here for You" project will strengthen our community's ability to provide care for indigent, low and moderate-income residents, minorities, and vulnerable populations who are experiencing mental illness and addiction. This position is a full-time temporary position expected to last 2 years from the date of hire, with a strong likelihood of continuation for a candidate with exemplary performance. This project will look to establish, strengthen and sustain referral pathways and new community locations to gain and retain minority and disadvantaged clients so that they can receive high-quality patient-centered outpatient services, trauma-informed screening, assessment, diagnosis and patient-centered treatment services.

The Case Manager position reports directly to the Here for You Project Director and collaborates with the Case Management Team Coordinator. The Case Manager may seek out assistance from any staff member regarding unique needs presented by a client and will respond to requests for assistance from peers and other staff. The Case Manager will serve as a member of a multidisciplinary treatment team and will be included in those case reviews and other meetings dealing with clients for which they are responsible. The Case Manager coordinates their activities with outside agencies involved in client treatment teams, case managers, families, guardians, advocates, and a variety of referral agencies.

Case Managers - Responsibilities:

- Knowledge of Mental Health symptoms disorders, use symptoms, disorders and diagnosis required.
- Assessing client's level of need, monitoring client's symptoms and functioning.
- Providing direct-care services to clients.
- Coordination with access to care with Clinicians providing direct services.
- Must possess the ability to determine level and type of services necessary for clients to improve and function in the community.

Case Managers – Requirements:

- Successful candidates must have Bachelor's or Master's degree in a related field.
- Candidates must possess excellent organizational, & communication skills.
- Completing concurrent notes and keeping all client and practice records up to date daily.
- Maintaining effective rapport with each client and maintaining a positive interactive style.
- Valid Ohio Driver's License.
