We would like to invite your company to sponsor the 9th annual KJ's 5k for Mental Health & Animal Rescue. The 5k will be held on the morning of Saturday, October 4, 2025, at Portage Lakes State Park, while a virtual KJ's 5k is available nationwide throughout the month of September in recognition of National Suicide Prevention Month.

KJ's 5k aims to stem the tide of the **suicide epidemic.** For the last 23 years, the suicide rate has increased nationwide by over 37.15%. In 2023 alone, the U.S. recorded 49,000 deaths by suicide, this equates to 1 death every 11 minutes. Roughly 1.5 million individuals attempted suicided. Here in Summit County, the suicide rate stands at 17 per 100,000, or nearly 15% ABOVE the national average.

Where does my Sponsorship Donation go?

Basic Community Suicide Prevention/Awareness Training

Portage Path works with local companies to train their staff members on how to recognize common signs of mental illness, warning signs of suicide, and what to do when they suspect they see these signs. Suicide and attempts cost America more than \$1 billion annually and can cost individual businesses tens of thousands of dollars annually.

The Portage Path Fund

This unrestricted fund allows Portage Path to serve 10,000 local people each year. Contributions to the Portage Path Fund allow us to conduct suicide prevention and awareness efforts, public education programs, professional development for staff, cover operating expenses, repairs, maintenance and equipment as needed to support the mission of Portage Path.

Client Needs Fund

Most Portage Path clients live on less than \$800 per month. Donations of personal care items, winter clothing, gently used purses, new socks or the funds to purchase similar items can make a real difference to people in recovery. Other times, there are non-behavioral health related services that they cannot otherwise afford which can be covered by this fund in extraordinary circumstances.

Creation and Distribution of Suicide Awareness and Prevention Materials

Design, printing, and distribution of suicide prevention literature, brochures, FAQs, a directory of resources, and other materials to let people know where and how to find help.

KJ Hamblin Scholarship

Provides a \$500 scholarship annually to one student at Coventry High School who will be going to college in a field of study related to KJ's interests or mental health.

Donation to Animal Charities

A portion of the proceeds are donated to Summit County Animal Control and Rubber City Rescue to help provide supplies, food, medicine and other resources for the care and adoption of animals in Summit County
